First, check for basics:

- Capital letters
- Punctuation
- Spellings including common exception words

Next, did you remember to tell the reader -

- What you could see
- What you could hear
- What you could smell

Finally let's check the quality features you used:

- Rich vocabulary ([thesaurus.com](https://www.thesaurus.com))
- Expanded noun phrases
- Prepositions
- Range of punctuation

If you have missed anything out, add words in or write additional sentences or paragraphs underneath or on other page.

Top tips

- *Editing and improving writing takes time. Children should spend the time given doing this, even if this means reading over their writing several times until the task is completed.*

Maths - I can add amounts of money.

Top tips

- Use the drawings on the previous page to show your child how to add the two prices together. (your child should hopefully recognise these methods despite my amateur drawings, the track pad is not the easiest for these things!)
- Children should use the column method if they can do, number line if they are less confident
- Remind children to write the tens underneath the line when they exchange (carry it over)
- Number lines must include the numbers in between to show where you landed (if children miss this step out they will not be able to fix it if they make an error as there is no way to know where they went wrong)
