Using your green Pupil Anthology book (paper for some people) read pages 22-24 'A Lion in the Meadow'. Then answer the questions on page 25 in your blue home learning book.

You should read the text through more than once to make sure you understand it and check any unknown words with an adult, you could use [dictionary.com](https://www.dictionary.com) to help.

Top tips for parents -

- Reading comprehension questions are pointless for a child who has not understood what they have read, ask your child to tell you what they have learned before they start answering. Perhaps ask them to tell you what they thought the message or lesson to be learned was from this story. Doing the activity before the questions will give you a clue how much they have understood.

Maths - I can add amounts of money.

Top tips

- Use the drawings on the previous page to show your child how to add the two prices together. (your child should hopefully recognise these methods despite my amateur drawings, the track pad is not the easiest for these things!)
- Children should use the column method if they can do, number line if they are less confident
- Remind children to write the tens underneath the line when they exchange (carry it over)
- Number lines must include the numbers in between to show where you landed (if children miss this step out they will not be able to fix it if they make an error as there is no way to know where they went wrong)
