During Summer Two we will be focusing on our recovery curriculum following lockdown. As a class, we will be focusing on place value and addition and subtraction to secure the foundation blocks for our mathematicians. We will continue to use a concrete, pictorial and abstract approach to lessons to support the children understanding. We will also work hard on our problem solving and reasoning skills. The children will have access to Mathletics and TTRockstar to support home learning and their basic fluency.

English

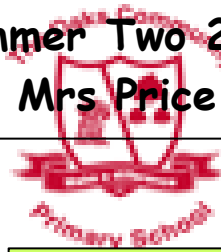
In our writing we will be using the vehicle text 'In to the Forest' The children will be writing a **newspaper report** to inform their audience about their experiences and the children will write their own **narrative**. We will continue to teach the children to read through whole class **Steps to Read** lessons using a variety of texts including plays and poetry. We will teach *all* aspects of word reading and comprehension through high-quality fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts. Some children will also access ReadingWise, BRP and RWI 1:1 sessions to boost their reading skills.

Science

In science we will be looking at plants. In this unit children will explore what plants need to grow well. They will compare how plants grow in different soils and explore how fertilisers can be used to improve growth. The class will investigate the amount of water needed to help a leafy pot plant grow well. They will also investigate how space affects plant growth by comparing how well grass seeds grow with more or less space.

Geography and History

This half term we will be looking at the big questions 'How do **plants survive in different environments?**' This big question links directly with our Science work and we will be using this as an opportunity to complete a lot of practical work. We will link this to geography, and we will look at plants from different countries and how they are adapted to suit their surroundings. We will also look at what plants we cannot grow in the UK and reasons for that.

Religious Studies

During our religious studies sessions we will be working on the Rights and Responsibilities award.

Physical Education

During our PE lessons will be looking at non-contact sport and we will be focusing on athletics.
