### Career of the week:

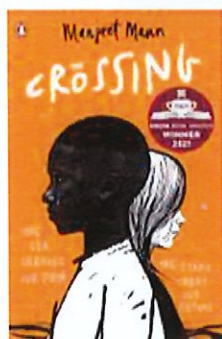
Job Title: Travel Agent
