

Literacy

This half term we will continue to explore traditional tales. We will be reading Little Red which is an adaptation of Little Red Riding Hood. In addition, we will be sharing the story 'Star In The Jar' by Sam Hay, beginning to write letters and words linked to the text.

Phonics

Phonics will continue to be delivered in short sessions daily that will focus on a new sound each day. Our focus is to teach the children to blend through 'Fred Talk' eg. c-a-t cat. You can support at home by 'Fred talking' just about anything. Put on your c-oa-t, make your b-e-d, put away the t-o-y-s.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be focussing on the numbers 0 to 6. This will include reviewing what we have already learned. We follow a mastery approach to maths which supports the children to develop a deep understanding of skills and concepts related to early numbers before moving on.
